- I. Introduction: The Missio Dei
- II. Exegeting God's Heart for the Nations [Acts 17:22-28]
 - A. What? "he made from one man every nation of mankind to live on all the face of the earth" [vs. 26a] Missio Dei and:
 - Adam/Noah [Gen. 1:28; 9:1]
 - Abraham [Gen. 12:1-3]
 - Israel [Psalm 67:1-5; Psalm 96:3; Isaiah 49:6]
 - Jesus/Early Church [John 1:1-14; John 8:12; Matthew 5:14; Matthew 28:18-20; Acts 13:46-48]
 - B. **How?** "Having determined allotted periods and the boundaries of their dwelling place" [vs. 26b] God's Sovereignty and:
 - Babel [Gen. 11:8-9]
 - Exile [Jeremiah 29:4-7]
 - Persecution [Acts 8:1]
 - C. Why? "that they should seek God, and perhaps feel their way toward him and find him" [vs. 27]
 - Homer's Odyssey and Apostle Paul
 - Application: Redeemer as a light to the nations "over there" and "right here"
- III. Conclusion: Pervasive Glory, Light, and Multi-cultural Worship [Rev. 7:9-12; 21:23-26]
